

Situated at the southern tip of the spectacular Grampians
National Park, the Hotel offers a one-of-a-kind experience with

facilities and a selection of wine and nature-based experiences
all set against a stunning Victorian backdrop.

The 70 acres of manicured lawns and gardens at the historic 1800's Mount Sturgeon Homestead provides the perfect setting for corporate events, product launches, team building experiences and much more.

Our range of flexible event spaces include:

Mount Sturgeon Homestead and Station

The original structure of the Mount Sturgeon Homestead was built from local sandstone and bluestone in the 1840s by the first owner of the property, Dr Robert Martin. Highlights of the property include the Homestead's notable art collection which includes pieces by members of the Heidelberg School, Charles Conder, Clifton Pugh, Jan Hendrik Scheltema and Richard H. Shaw.

The Homestead also boasts manicured lawns and gardens and guests are invited to pick fruit from the orchard which houses some of the property's original trees. Mount Sturgeon Homestead is now an accommodation and/or events facility as part of the Royal Mail Hotel.

The Mount Sturegon Homestead is an ideal location for your meeting, with large windows allowing in natural light as well as balcony doors to allow fresh air, and of course an amazing view over Mount Sturgeon.









Event Spaces Continued

Mount Sturgeon Woolshed

The fully restored Mount Sturgeon Woolshed is used for concerts and weddings as well as for its original purpose – shearing. The original woolshed, completed in the 1840s was very similar to what exists today.

The Woolshed provides a large space, perfect for parties, product launches, art and music spaces, and performances.

Annexe Lounge Meeting Room

The Annexe Lounge is available for groups of up to 20 guests. It is located at the Royal Mail Hotel next to the Parker Street Project Restaurant. This includes use of our white board and our projector.

Wine Cellar

The Hotel's cellar houses one of the most comprehensive and varied wine collections in Australia, including one of the country's leading collections of Bordeaux and Burgundy.

A selection of 2300 local and imported wines is offered from a wine inventory of 28,000 bottles.

This space can be transformed into a private dining space, ideal forproduct launches, meetings, award ceremonies and special dinners.

Dining Options

The Royal Mail Hotel is renowned for its highly acclaimed dining offerings that are a reflection of Dunkeld's micro-climate and the exceptional produce growing capabilities of the Royal Mail Hotel Kitchen Garden, the largest working restaurant kitchen garden in Australia.

Wickens at Royal Mail Hotel

The Wickens at Royal Mail Hotel signature dining experience is an eight course (\$185 plus matched wines) Chef's Tasting menu with matched wines. A five course (\$145 plus matched wines) tasting menu and vegetarian and vegan Chef's Tasting menus are also available.

Parker Street Project

Occupying the space of the original Royal Mail Hotel dining room to become an all-day casual eatery on the property, serving breakfast, lunch and dinner.

On the menu, diners will see parallels with Executive Chef Robin Wickens British background under the headings snacks; medium; large and dessert plates. A \$50.00 'Feed Me' menu is also available.

Activities

The Royal Mail Hotel has many activities for your guests to enjoy over the duration of their stay:

Wine Cellar

The hotels wine cellar houses one of the most comprehensive and varied wine collections in Australia. It boasts an inventory of 30,000 wines.

Guests can enjoy a tour of our wine cellar with the sommelier including a tasting and nibbles. We can arrange for a private group tour, to suit your budget.

Kitchen Garden Tour

Conducted by the Royal Mail Hotel's chefs, the complimentary tour demonstrates the organic practices employed by the hotel and how the daily harvest influences the menu.

Walking

There are many walking trails in Dunkeld and each guest will receive a map on check-in. The Mount Sturgeon Property offers some excellent nature trails with points of interest along the way including a heritage listed gum tree and a stone wall built by the Chinese during the gold rush.

Grampians Golf Course

Grampians golf club is located a short drive from Dunkeld at the base of Mount Abrupt in the Southern Grampians. This spectacular 18 hole golf course provides stunning views of the Grampians.









Accommodation

Located within the landscaped gardens of the hotel, with panoramic views of the Southern Grampians, are the Deluxe Mountain View Rooms and One and Two Bedroom Apartments. Additional Garden rooms are available opposite the Royal Mail Hotel on Parker Street.

Also located directly opposite the Hotel on Parker Street is Mulberry House, a fully restored four bedroom house which sleeps up to 11 guests.

How to book

Deposits and Payment Schedule

The booking is not considered confirmed until a signed terms and conditions document is received and a deposit paid.

A deposit consists of 25% of your wedding package. 50% of your expected spend is due 6 months from your event. 25% of your expected spend is due 1 month from your event.

Balance of expected spend with final guest numbers is due 1 month from your event. Final numbers cannot be reduced from this date.

Accommodation for your Guests

Upon confirmation of your wedding with the Royal Mail Hotel, a selection of accommodation will be placed on hold for your guests.

Guests may contact the Royal Mail Hotel reservations to book their accommodation.


Early booking is advised. Please remind guests to mention they are attending your event. Any unbooked accommodation will be released 30 days from your event.
