#### 1. Montara Wines

Cellar Door Friday to Sunday: 11am – 4pm 76 Chalambar Rd, Ararat

A short drive off the Western Highway, stop into Montara and enjoy a wine on the deck overlooking the vineyard and Mount Langi Ghiran. Grab a cheeseboard filled with local produce and enjoy the view.

Ask about the colonial style cellar door and its construction.

### 2. Grampians Estate

Cellar Door Everyday: 10am – 5pm 1477 Western Highway, Great Western

Known for its sparkling shiraz, chardonnay and cool climate shiraz, pull into Grampians Estate on the Western Highway. With friendly staff, you'll leave with a wealth of knowledge.

Ask about the Grampians Estate wine labels and why they are significant.





# 3. Seppelts

Tours of The Drive Everyday on the hour: 11am – 3pm 36 Cemetery Road, Great Western

Established in 1851, Seppelts is a winery rich in history. When visiting, tour the heritage-listed cellars. These cellars, also known as The Drives, were first excavated in 1868 and are three kilometers below ground.

Ask about the long history of Seppelts, its wines and wine cellars.

## 4. Best's Wines

Cellar Door Monday to Saturday: 10am – 5pm 111 Bests Road, Great Western

Explore the historic underground Concongella Cellars and learn about the history of Australia's wine industry. Taste limited-release wines at the cellar door.

Ask about the two families that have owned and operated the winery for its 150 years.
